Monday, April 24 – Drive to Lee Vining (300 miles; 5.5 hours)

Drive to Lee Vining Stay at the Lake View Lodge

Tuesday, April 25 – Death Valley (355 miles; 7 hours)

Drive to Death Valley via 120 East into Nevada and then down to Beatty Stop in Rhyolite near east entrance to Death Valley Goldwell Open Air Museum Rhyolite Ghost Town Stop at Furnace Creek Visitor Center to find out off-road conditions Drive to Eureka Dunes, which included 40 miles of off-roading Camp at primitive Eureka Dunes campground at base of dune

Wednesday, April 26 – Death Valley (106 miles; 4 hours)

Hike 2.3 miles (RT) to summit of Eureka Dunes Drive out to Big Pine to get gas Drive 40 miles on rough dirt road to Saline Valley hot springs Enjoy the palm oasis and hot pools Camp in primitive Saline Valley Warm Springs Campground Do battle with wild burros throughout the night

Thursday, April 27 – Bishop (85 miles; 3.5 hours)

Drive the rough Saline Valley Road out to civilization Stay at Bishop Village Inn just off Main Street in Bishop

Friday, April 28 – Long Valley Primitive Hot Springs and South Lake Tahoe (207 miles; 6.5 hours)

Drive up Highway 395 towards South Lake Tahoe Explore the Long Valley primitive hot springs area off of Benton Crossing Road (accessible by dirt roads – some okay for 2WD while others require 4WD) Crowley Hot Spring (Wild Willy's) Hilltop Hot Spring (Pulky's Pool) Alkali Lake Hot Spring The Crab Cooker (this one we soaked in) Hot Creek Geothermal Area Continue on to South Lake Tahoe Have dinner at Base Camp Pizza Stay at Big Pines Mountain House
