Day 1 – Holiday Park Campground, Greensboro, Maryland (227 miles; 4.5 hours)

Drive 4.5 hours to Greensboro, Maryland Stay at Holiday Park Campground – use as base camp for 4 nights

Day 2 – Wye Oak State Park / Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum (110 miles; 2.5 hours)

Drive to St. Michaels (about an hour from the campground) Along the way, stop to see the famous Wye Oak In St. Michaels, tour the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum Drive to the end of Tilghman Island and back Drive back to the campground

Day 3 – Annapolis (108 miles; 2.5 hours)

Drive the 1.25 hours to Annapolis Tour the U.S. Naval Academy Tour the Maryland State House Have dinner at Buddy's Crabs and Ribs Drive back to the campground

Day 4 – Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge (108 miles; 2.5 hours)

Drive the 1.25 hours to Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge Bike ride the 5-mile Wildlife Loop Walk the Marsh End and Woods Trails Drive back to the campground

Day 5 – Eastern Neck National Wildlife Refuge (261 miles; 5.25 hours)

Drive the 1.25 hours to Eastern Neck National Wildlife Refuge Walk the nature trails
Drive the remaining 4 hours home
