#### Thursday, January 11 – Pu'u wa'awa'a Cinder Cone hike and Hapuna Beach

Hike 7.5 miles (RT) to the summit of the Pu'u wa'awa'a cinder cone

Relax on Hapuna Beach on the Kohala coast

Stay at Castle Kona Bali Kai on Alii Drive in Kailua

## Friday, January 12 - Golden Pools of Ke-awa-iki and Anaeho'omalu Beach

Hike 1.5 miles (RT) along a lava trail to a Keawaiki beach

Spend the afternoon relaxing on beautiful Anaeho'omalu Beach

Stay at Castle Kona Bali Kai on Alii Drive in Kailua

# Saturday, January 13 - Hikiau Heiau, Pu'uhonua O Honaunau National Historical Park, and snorkeling in Honaunau Bay
