## Day 1 - L. L. Bean ( 327 miles; 6.5 hours)

Drive $61 / 4$ hours to Yarmouth, Maine to see Delorme’s Eartha (World’s Largest Revolving Globe)

Drive remaining half hour to L. L. Bean store in Freeport, Maine
Shop all night - store open 24 hours
Stay in L. L. Bean Parking Lot
Day 2 - Acadia National Park (150 miles; 3 hours)
Drive 3 hours to Acadia National Park - Blackwoods Campground
Play in snow at campground
Stay at Blackwoods Campground in the Park
Day 3 - Acadia National Park (0 miles; 0 hours)
Drive into Bar Harbor to rent cross country skis for the boys
Drive the Park Loop Road
Stop at Thunder Hole
Cross country ski from Thunder Hole along the cliff trail to Sand Beach
Stay at Blackwoods Campground again
Day 4 - Acadia / Kankamangus Highway / Tree Farm Campground, Vermont (385 miles; 8 hours)

Cross country ski along Eagle Lake in Acadia
Return skis in Bar Harbor
Head towards Vermont across New Hampshire via the Kankamangus Highway
Stop at Sabbaday Falls Picnic Area and hike to the falls
Drive remaining 3 hours to Springfield, Vermont
Stay at Tree Farm Campground
Day 5 - Okemo Ski Area ( $\mathbf{3 8}$ miles; 1 hour)
Drive $1 / 2$ hour to Okemo Ski Area
Downhill ski for the day
Drive back to and stay at Tree Farm Campground again

## Day 6 - Weston Country Store, Clark Art Institute, Mt. Brodie Ski Area (83 miles; 1.75 hours) <br> Drive $1 / 2$ hour to the famous Weston Country Store <br> Spend some time browsing in the store <br> Drive 1 hour to Williamstown, Massachusetts <br> Visit the Clark Art Institute <br> Drive another 15 minutes to Mt. Brodie Ski Area <br> Stay at Mt. Brodie Campground right alongside the ski slopes

Day 7 - Mt. Brodie Ski Area (0 miles; $\mathbf{0}$ hours)
Downhill ski for the day
Day 8 - Home (157 miles; 3 hours)
Drive remaining 3 hours home
Total Trip Mileage: 1140 miles
Average Miles per Day: 142 miles per day
